Access Policy Introduction

This policy statement sets out the schools' arrangements for managing the access of providers to pupils at the school for the purpose of giving them information about the provider's education or training offer. This complies with the school's legal obligations under Section 42B of the Education Act 1997.

Pupil entitlement

All pupils in years 7-13 are entitled:

- to find out about technical education qualifications and apprenticeships opportunities, as part of a careers programme which provides information on the full range of education and training options available at each transition point;
- to hear from a range of local providers about the opportunities they offer, including technical education and apprenticeships – through options events, assemblies and group discussions and taster events;
- to understand how to make applications for the full range of academic and technical courses.

Management of provider access requests

Procedure

A provider wishing to request access should contact the staff identified in appendix 1.

Opportunities for access

A number of events, integrated into the schools' careers programmes, will offer providers an opportunity to come into school to speak to pupils and/or their parents/carers. Details of the current programme are included in appendix 2.

The Federation's policies on safeguarding and visitors set out the schools' approach to allowing providers into school as visitors talk to our students. These can be found on the schools' websites.

Premises and facilities

The schools will make the main hall, classrooms or private meeting rooms available for discussions between the provider and students, as appropriate to the activity.

The schools will also make available AV and other specialist equipment to support provider presentations. This will all be discussed and agreed in advance of the visit with the Careers Leader or Careers Link Worker.

Providers are welcome to leave a copy of their prospectus or other relevant course literature in the Careers Interview Room, which is managed by the Careers team.
