Dear Parent/Carer

Your child has been selected to attend the trip to Shakespeare's Globe, London to watch a production of Macbeth, on Thursday 10 March.

The group will meet at the Red Funnel car ferry in East Cowes at 8.45 am on Thursday 10 March and will return by 8.30 pm on the same day. They will travel to and from Shakespeare's Globe, London by coach. It is school policy that students should not make their own transport arrangements for travel to or from visit venues, nor to or from meeting points. Please ensure, therefore, that your child gets safely to and from the departure and arrival points.

The play begins at 2.00 pm and the students will experience what it was like to watch a play during Shakespeare's time by watching from 'The Pit' as 'groundlings'. They will remain standing for the duration of the production.

The member of staff in charge of the group is Mrs Smith accompanied by Mr Parr-Burman, Mr Cameron, Ms Ryan, Ms Thorpe, Mr Norman and Ms Edwards.

The cost of the visit is £28.00, which includes ferry and coach travel as well as entry tickets to Shakespeare's Globe. This price does not include food so please make sure that students bring enough food and drink to last them for the whole day. (Should your child receive Free School Meals, then a packed lunch will be provided for them.)

Payment is now due and should be made via the School Gateway by Monday 31 January. Whilst we appreciate that any contribution is voluntary, please be aware that this is the minimum contribution needed from each student for the trip to take place. Should you require financial support please email annie.smith@iwef.org.uk explaining your circumstances. Insurance for students is provided by the school.

The attached form needs to be returned to Ms Ryan in the Library at Carisbrooke College or Mrs O'Callaghan in the Library at Medina College.
