Dear parents/carers,

I am writing to you about two days this term which will have an impact on the school's daily routine. These relate to The Isle of Wight Festival, and the impact that it has on us as a school and the The Queen's Platinum Jubilee

The Isle of Wight Festival is Thursday, 16 June to Sunday, 19 June 2022.

For safety reasons, Medina College will not be open to students in person on Friday, 17 June. **The only exception to this is Year 11 students taking exams, in which case these will be taking place on site as planned.**

For all other year groups, teaching will be delivered remotely via Google Classroom. Please encourage your children to engage with this, as it is important that their learning continues and they submit the work that is set.

Details relating to the road and travel plans for the area will be shared with you nearer the time.

For clarity, there is no impact on Carisbrooke College or The Island VI Form. Both of these sites will be open as normal on Friday, 17 June.

Additionally, in line with the Queen's Platinum Jubilee we are entitled to an additional bank holiday this school year. As this event falls within our current half term we are taking **Monday 20 June** as our additional bank holiday. Therefore, Medina College will not be open to students on this day. As with Friday, 17 June, **the only exception to this is Year 11 students taking exams, in which case these will be taking place on site as planned.** This will also be the case for Carisbrooke College and The Island VI Form.
