Dear Parents/Carers

Thank you for your support throughout the start of the exam season for the Year 11 students. Although there are still over two weeks of exams remaining, we are writing to you regarding your child's leavers assembly and their last day in school for lessons.

We have carefully looked at the exam timetables and logistical aspects of events at this time of year and have set the Year 11 leavers assembly as period 5 on Tuesday 14 June.

This means that after this date, the students will only be expected to attend school for their exams. I would like to remind you that they must be in full uniform when they are in for exams. We will impress upon them how important it is that they continue to be on time for their exams, please can you also support us with this message. Breakfast will continue to be available for the morning exams. The exam page on [our website](#) has a copy of the exam timetable.

As a reminder, Fairlee Road will have diversions in place around the Isle of Wight Festival period, so please ensure that your child leaves adequate time to get to school. School buses will be running on Friday 17 June to get to school, but students will need to make their own arrangements for getting home after the morning exam has finished.
