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Health and Social Care: Component 1: Human Lifespan Development: students will study life events including: physical events, relationship changes and life circumstances
History: Conflict and tension in Asia 1950-1975: students will focus on the causes and events of the Cold War in Asia and understand how and why conflict occurred
Mandarin: Festivals: students will study Chinese festival and learn new 'miscellaneous' characters
Maths: Students will study geometry. They will learn about angles and bearings, working with circles and vectors
MUSIC: Beethoven and Schwartz: students will study Beethoven's 'Pathetique Sonata' and Schwartz's 'Wicked - Defying Gravity'
Personal Development: Students will consider the impact of physical and mental health in reaching goals and on relationships
PE: Games and PE: students will partake in activities such as basketball, rugby, short tennis, badminton and handba
RE, Philosophy and Ethics: Component 1: Relationships Key religion: Christianity: students will consider the characteristics of relationships, marriage and family life through a study of beliefs and teachings
