Cells and Circles': Students will show development of ideas towards a final resolve and refine their ideas through exploration of media

'Putting a business idea into practice' and 'Understanding external influences of a Business': Students will continue with their study of these concepts and learn about the importance of cash and cash flow

Child Development: Unit 1: Students will learn about working with children aged 0-5 years

Algorithms: Students will learn about the terms 'decomposition', 'abstraction', and 'algorithmic thinking'. They will be able to use trace tables

Design and Technology: Students will learn about business and enterprise, market push and pull, continual product improvement, impact of technology on jobs, culture and society, virtual marketing and retail, crowdfunding, cooperatives and fairtrade. The practical elements focus around the design and make of their NEA

Devising from a stimulus: Students will work in small groups and use a stimulus to devise a piece of original theatre

Narrative: Students will undertake an independent project. They will decide on a chosen project brief and begin to study artists and designers linked to this brief. They will demonstrate and refine skills learnt on Illustrator by developing studies and planning responses

Human Lifespan Development: Students will investigate how individuals deal with life events
