Dear Parent/Carer

Your child has been selected to attend a visit to watch Wicked at the Mayflower Theatre, Southampton, on Thursday 13 June 2024. This trip will help consolidate the students' learning on fairy tales this term.

The group will travel from school by coach to the East Cowes Red Funnel Car Ferry, where they will travel to Southampton. However, please note, the students will need to be collected from the East Cowes Red Funnel Car Ferry Terminal at 7.00 pm on their return.

Students will walk to the theatre which will take approximately 30 minutes and so waterproof coats will be necessary. It is school policy that students should not make their own transport arrangements for travel to or from visit venues, nor to or from meeting points. Please ensure, therefore, that your child gets safely to and from the departure and arrival points.

The member of staff in charge of the group is Mrs Smith accompanied by Mrs Lythgoe, Mrs Thompson and Mr Burnett

The cost of the visit is £40 with the first payment of £20 being due by Monday 1 April; the second payment of £20 is due by Wednesday 1 May. This price does not include food so please make sure that students bring enough food and drink to last them for the whole day. Should your child receive Free School Meals, then a packed lunch will be provided for them.
