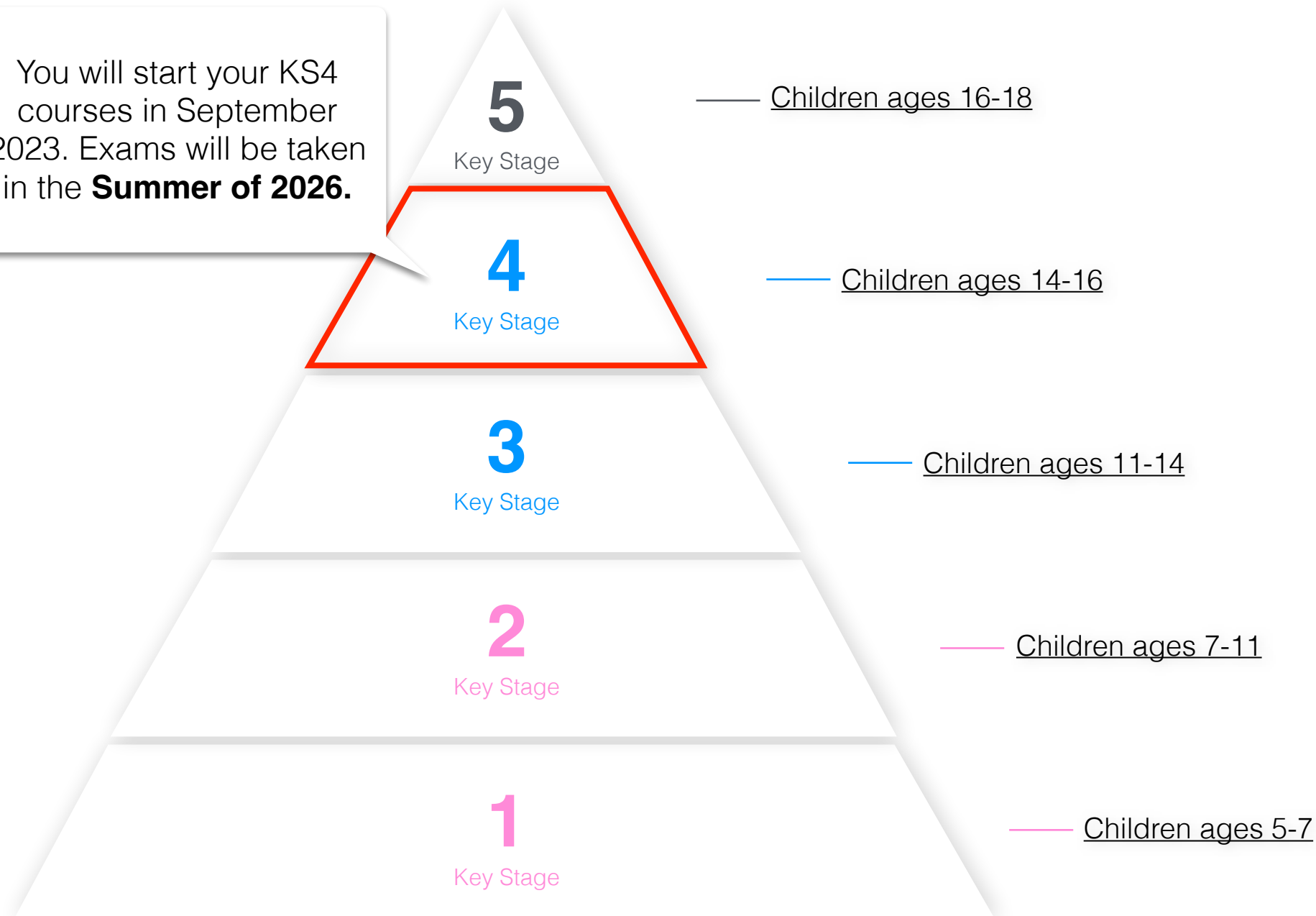


# Stages of your education

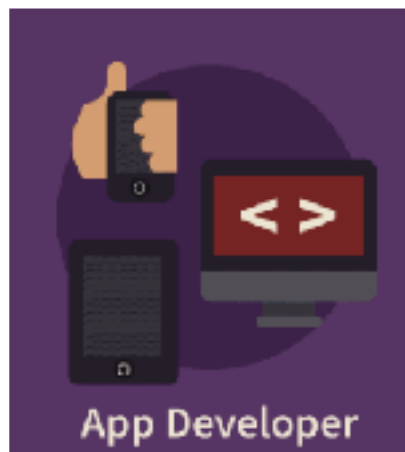

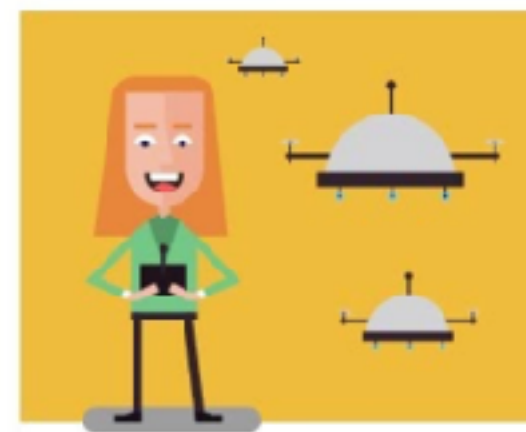

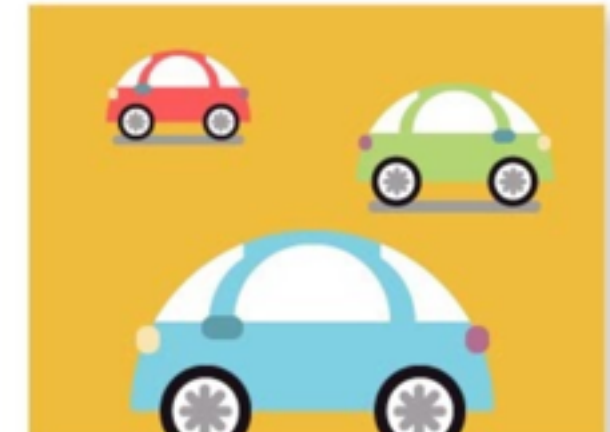
