Please do take time to read all of this information, share the relevant parts with your child and complete all of the necessary sections. It is important that we have the details of the most efficient way to contact you, this is an email address and a mobile phone number. The email address is used for both school wide and targeted communication and your mobile number is the most useful for emergency contact. The mobile number is also for the texting system, used to communicate more urgent general messages. We urge you to provide us with these two pieces of information. If, alternatively, you do require hard copies of communication from school, we can post them, but please bear in mind that this will take longer to receive.

When completed, this form will contain very important information regarding you and your child, including contact details, medical information, parental/student permissions and agreements that both you and your child will have signed, setting out general expectations and explaining acceptable computer use.

This has been designed to capture information that will support your child's transition to Carisbrooke College. It will help when we start thinking about the right tutor groups for your child, with class seating plans and for teachers to start getting a sense of your child and their unique interests.
