Dear Parent/Carer

Your child has, throughout the year, performed to an outstanding level and as a result has been highlighted as one of the top students in Year 10 in terms of gaining achievement points and all round engagement in their education and learning. As a result we would like to offer them the opportunity to attend the end of year rewards trip to Thorpe park Tuesday 2 July 2024.

The programme for the day is outlined below:

6:45 am Coach to Wightlink Fishbourne  
7:40 am Ferry from Fishbourne to Portsmouth via Wightlink  
10:30 am Approx arrival at Thorpe Park

4:50 pm Approx departure from Thorpe Park  
7:20 pm Ferry from Portsmouth to Fishbourne via Wightlink  
8:25 pm Approx arrival back at Medina College

Students will all need to wear comfortable clothing and take with them food and drink to last throughout the day. If your child receives free school meals then a packed lunch will be provided. I also recommend sun cream and a sun hat if the weather looks like making this appropriate.

In order to make the trip viable we have subsidised what we can as a school, leaving the cost per student to pay to be £46.00. To further support, we are offering parents/carers the chance to pay in two instalments via the Arbor account. The first instalment of £23.00 is to be paid by 30 April and the second instalment of £23.00 to be paid by 31 May.
